Flipgrid

- Asynchronous online video communication platform
- Instructors create “grids” (containers for “topics”).
- “Topics” are prompts to which students reply.





Why Flipgrid

- Easy to use
- Works on smartphones and tablets.
- Students can record, re-record, and edit their recordings.
- Instructors set the recording length (15 seconds to 10 minutes).
- Students can link external resources.



Flipgrid and Oral Assessment

- “Grids” are tests.
- “Topics” are test questions.
- “Focus” is a test prompt.
